



Applications and payment

- Places are allocated on a first-come-first-served basis.
- Camp fees need to be fully paid upon enrolment. We have the right to exclude participants from camps for the non-payment of fees.
- You are asked to inform the office in writing should you wish to make any changes after the application is submitted. Please see below for our policies on withdrawals and change of booking.
- Please check the time, date, venue and the prerequisites carefully as outlined on the schedule.
- The booking is non-transferable.

Policy on Withdrawal, Absence, Cancellations

- Booking confirmation will be sent to you by email. Camp reminders will be sent to you 2 weeks before the first day of camp. Please regularly check your email, including your spam folder, to ensure you receive our messages. If you're not receiving our emails, check your junk mail and confirm that we have updated your contact details. We cannot be held responsible for missed camps due to unread emails or messages landing in your spam folder.
- To ensure swift communication during emergencies, participants must provide at least one emergency contact with a local phone number. In the event of an accident, we will immediately call this number. If we cannot reach you, we will send an email to notify you of the incident.


